

**1. What is our research question?**

Research plan What do the children of the middle class prefer the least watching a film without hearing anything or not being able to see it?

**2. How does this research fit the theme of the project?**

The theme was about senses and we are researching which senses children from the middle school would rather miss.

**3. What do we think will be the answer to the research question? And why do we think this will be the answer?**

[Researchers call this a 'hypothesis']

We thought the children would rather be deaf than blind, because a film is better understandable if you are deaf instead of blind.

**4. Which persons or what materials are we researching?**

Children from middle school.

**5. What is it that we will measure exactly?**

[Measuring can mean: measuring length, distance or weight.

Measuring can also mean: asking people in your research the same question and comparing the answers.]

We are going to measure whether children prefer to be deaf or blind.

**6. In what way will we do the measuring?**

[For example with a test, with a question or with interviews]

We'll show the children two similar videos. During the first video, we blindfold them. During the second video, they are given earplugs and we turn off the sound so that the children won't be able to hear anything. Then we ask them what they liked the least, and why.

**7. How many times or with how many people do we need to repeat our measuring to really know the answer to the question?**

With ten children.

**8. How will we record the results while we conduct our research?**

[For example: make a table, keep a tally or write down the answers.]

We'll write down their answers in a table, so that we can compare them later.

**9. What should stay the same in our research and what should change?**

The same: the video that is being watched, the space, the computer, the volume of the sound.

Different: watching the video's with blindfold or with ear plugs
